

**SECTION: 6. PRODUCT ORDERING****6.4 SPECIAL ORDERS**

- 6.4.1 A retail liquor store that wants to special order products not available in the Liquor Wholesale Price List shall engage the services of a liquor supplier or liquor agency or representative.

6.5 ESTATE PURCHASES

- 6.5.1 Under exceptional circumstances retail liquor stores may purchase liquor products from private parties or estates, with prior written authorization from the AGLC.
- 6.5.2 Approval will only be provided where it can be demonstrated that the liquor products were initially legally purchased in Alberta.

6.6 PRODUCT LABELLING

- 6.6.1 The liquor supplier or liquor agent of liquor products must ensure that labelling complies with Government of Canada labelling standards in terms of both the *Food and Drug Act* and the *Consumer Packaging and Labelling Act*.
- 6.6.2 The agent or supplier is responsible to provide confirmation of Government of Canada label approval or gain AGLC approval that federal standards are satisfied before a product is released for retail sale.
