

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that section 42 of the Liquor Control and Licensing Regulation, B.C. Reg. 244/2002, is amended

- (a) in subsection (1) by striking out "A person" and substituting "Subject to subsection (7), a person";
- (b) in subsection (2) by striking out "A licensee" and substituting "Subject to subsection (7), a licensee", and
- (c) by adding the following subsection:

(7) The holder of a food primary licence that has been issued in respect of a licensed establishment may allow a person to bring into the licensed establishment an unopened bottle of commercially-made wine for consumption in the licensed establishment, and, in that event, the holder of the food primary licence may serve that wine in accordance with the Act, this regulation and the terms and conditions of the licence.
