

22 (1) A brewery, winery or distillery may apply to the general manager to establish a liquor store at its manufacturing premises to sell its products to the general

public.

(2) For the purposes of subsection (1), the general manager may establish the store or the minister may appoint an agent at those premises

under section 18 (5).

Price reductions

23 If a particular brand or size of package of liquor has been delisted or is otherwise to be removed from the market, the general manager may reduce its retail price

in order to clear the inventory.

Conduct of stores

24 (1) The sale of liquor and products at a liquor store must be conducted by a person appointed under this Act, to be known as a "store manager".

(2) Under the direction of the general manager the store manager is responsible for carrying out this Act and the regulations as they relate to

the conduct of the liquor store and the sale of liquor and products.

(3) A store manager or a person acting as the clerk or employee of, or in any capacity for a store manager must not sell liquor in another

place or at another time or otherwise than as authorized under this Act.

(4) A store manager may accept returned liquor and refund the purchase price if satisfied that

(a) liquor has not been opened or tampered with, and is being returned for a good reason, or

(b) the liquor is defective.
