#### Highway Traffic (Zero Tolerance) Amendment Act

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

- 1. The  ${\it Highway\ Traffic\ Act\ R.S.P.E.I.\ 1988,\ Cap.\ H-5}$  is amended by this Act.
- 2. The Act is amended in the following provisions by the deletion of the words "age of 19 years" and the substitution of the words "age of 21 years":
  - (a) clause 277.1(10)(b);
  - (b) clause 277.8(1)(a);
  - (c) subsections 277.9(1) to (4);
  - (d) subclauses 277.9(5)(a)(i) and (ii);
  - (e) subclauses 277.9(6)(a)(i) and (ii);
  - (f) subsections 277.9(9), (13) and (14).
- 3. This Act comes into force on a date that may be fixed by proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** provides that the *Highway Traffic Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-5 is amended by this Act.

**SECTION 2** changes the age of persons not allowed to have a blood alcohol level exceeding zero milligrams of alcohol in 100 millilitres of blood from those under the age of 19 years to those under the age of 21 years.

**SECTION 3** provides for the commencement of this Act.
