Under the authority of sections 61 and 68 of the Liquor Control Act and the Subordinate Legislation Revision and Consolidation Act, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the *Liquor Limitation Order* .

Liquor brought into province limited

2. The prescribed amount of liquor which a person on any one occasion may bring into the province from a part of Canada other than the province shall not exceed

- (a) 40 ounces or 1.14 litres of spirits;

- (b) 40 ounces or 1.14 litres of wine; and
- (c) 2 dozen bottles or cans or 9 litres of beer.
